



Junior Miss Dress Guidelines

Interview and Speech:

- A nice sundress/interview dress/jumpsuit that is age and length appropriate. Dress should not be too short or too tight.
- Interview and Speech attire can be the same, or different per contestants choice.
- A clean dressy sandal or dress shoe should be worn. No flip flops. Height of heel should be age appropriate and at a level that can be walked in gracefully.
- Hair should be clean and neat.
- Nails should be clean, and can be painted, suggest a neutral color.
- Age appropriate make-up is acceptable
- Earrings, necklaces, rings and bracelets are acceptable, but kept tasteful.
- Proper undergarments should be worn but not visible.
- No hair or body glitter.

Formal:

- Any length dress is acceptable. Think "Sunday Best" "Homecoming" "Prom"
- The dress should be age appropriate
- Keep your shoes at a height you can walk comfortably in them
- Proper undergarments should be worn but not seen
- Age appropriate make-up
- Earrings, necklaces, rings and bracelets are acceptable, but kept to a minimum
- No hair or body glitter
