

Queens Responsibilities

If you are crowned, as a representative of the Round Lake Area, there are several events that you should plan to attend.

- **PARADES:** There are several opportunities for the Queens to be part of local parades.
- **EVENTS:** The Round Lake Area Pageant Directors will always provide you with upcoming events. There are opportunities to attend other local village pageants as well as participate in Round Lake area events. You may also suggest events that you and your family like to attend. You are required to attend a minimum of 10 Round Lake events throughout the year (not including parades and local pageants).
- **LAKE COUNTY ILLINOIS STATE PAGEANT:** The Round Lake Area Pageant is a part of the Lake Illinois State Pageant System. It is mandatory of the Round Lake Area Queens to compete in the Lake County Illinois State Pageant and attend all scheduled events before.
- **TOWN PAGEANTS AND EVENTS:** We encourage our new Queens to attend other LCIS town pageants and events throughout the summer. It's a great way to make new friends!
- **THANK YOU CARD DELIVERY:** Each Queen is required to write and sign cards that will later be sent out to the Round Lake Area Pageant Judges and Sponsors. We will do this as a group at our first meeting after the pageant.
- **HOLIDAY SEASON:** Like the summer, the holiday season is a very busy time for the Round Lake Area Pageant. The Queens are required to attend all four Round Lake Villages tree lightings and any other assigned holiday events (i.e. Spaghetti Supper with Santa, Shop With a Cop). Along with this, the Queens are required to personally deliver holiday cookies and cards to all Round Lake Village Halls, Police Departments, Fire Departments and major donors. We will do this as a group as part of our Holiday Fun!
- Miss Round Lake Area Queens agree not to enter any other pageant during their reign without Director approval. All personal appearances, photographic sessions, and photographic releases **must be approved in advance by the pageant director.**

We understand you are students, as well as involved with many activities and we will try to work events and activities around your other commitments, but we ask that you be prepared to attend the majority of these activities if crowned.
